

The 4th Sunday of Advent:

Joy

Take ten minutes before dinner to light the four candles on the advent wreath. Remember to talk about the hope, peace, love, and joy we have at Christmas. Notice how the candles are different lengths. This reminds us that we sometimes have to wait for God to answer our prayers, just like the world had to wait for Jesus to be born. On Christmas Day, make sure to light all four candles and the Christ candle in the middle.

Sunday: Make a list of all the things God has done in your family and rejoice in them.

Monday: 1 Peter 1:8-9 Why do we rejoice with great joy?

Tuesday: Matthew 13:44 Why does the man in this parable joyfully sell all that he has?

Wednesday: Take a walk after dinner and enjoy the lights on your neighbors house.

Thursday: Luke 19:6 Why did Zacchaeus receive Jesus joyfully?

Christmas Day: Luke 2:8-14 Why is the angels message, "Good news of great joy?"

Family Activity:

Go to the Christmas Eve service and experience great joy as you worship with Gods people.

On Christmas morning read the Christmas story in Luke 2:1-20.
